

NOSSCR Supreme Court Group Admission

Monday, June 17, 2019

IMPORTANT INFORMATION, DATES & DEADLINES

- NOSSCR's group admission will include an admission ceremony, along with a continental breakfast, group photograph, and a courtroom lecture
 - **ALL APPLICANTS MUST REPORT TO THE COURT NO LATER THAN 9:00 AM**
- Only attorneys who are current NOSSCR members, have been admitted to a state bar for at least **THREE YEARS**, and are in **good standing** may apply/participate
- NOSSCR's group admission is limited to **50 applicants**; **spots will be filled on a first come, first served basis**
 - Each applicant may bring **ONE guest** over the age of six to the admission ceremony
- APPLICATION PACKETS must include the following documents, **assembled in this exact order**, paperclipped together (PLEASE DO NOT STAPLE), and mailed to NOSSCR (ATTN: Lea Ko, Staff Attorney) **on/or before APRIL 1, 2019**:
 - COMPLETED **Application for Admission to Practice** (aka personal statement) SIGNED by TWO sponsors who are members of the Supreme Court bar and not related to the applicant
 - **THE FIRST PAGE OF THE ADMISSION APPLICATION MUST BE TYPED AND CANNOT BE HANDWRITTEN (PER THE COURT'S ADMISSIONS CLERK, THE SECOND PAGE MAY BE HANDWRITTEN)**
 - **Certificate of Good Standing** from the highest court of the state in which the applicant is admitted
 - Certificate must be dated within one year of the application date
 - **Check for \$200 made payable to the "Supreme Court of the United States" and dated June 17, 2019**
 - **Checks cannot be dated more than three months in advance of the admission ceremony, as they will not be honored by the Department of the Treasury**
- **Please note that your spot is not guaranteed unless/until your complete application packet, including your admission fee check, is received by NOSSCR on/or before the April 1, 2019 deadline**
 - You will receive a confirmation email from NOSSCR upon receipt of your application packet guaranteeing your spot or explaining why your spot could not be guaranteed (e.g. failure to adhere to the deadline, missing, incomplete, or outdated application materials, or no more available spots)
- DO NOT MAIL ANY APPLICATIONS OR DOCUMENTS TO THE SUPREME COURT!
